In the summer of 2018, 14 girls from Mendota Elementary met twice a week for 8 weeks at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Students learned directly from professors and professionals about how artificial intelligence (AI) is used in the fields of medicine, business, and more! They explored the local physics, geology, and art museums and even created their own Scratch coding projects.
